What will your child be learning about this half term?

In **English** we will be reading stories such as 'We're all Wonders' by R.J. Palacio, 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne, and 'The Dot' by Peter H. Reynolds.

We will be writing in different genres including blurbs, imaginative writing, and writing the moral of the story. In **maths**, we will be focusing on comparing length and height, solving problems for mass and weight, and learning about volume and capacity. We will be learning to read and write numbers to 100, multiplying by 2s, 5s and 10s and divide using objects.

Our topic in **science** is 'Everyday Materials' and we will be exploring materials through investigations.

Our learning quest this half term is 'What similarities and differences do we share?'

We will be focusing on learning skills in **geography** such as comparing and contrasting the UK and China.

In **art**, we will be learning about the artist Henri Matisse and developing our collage skills.

In **music**, our focus will be on learning to sing and perform the song 'Your imagination'.

In **Religion and Worldviews**, we will be learning about Places of Worship, with specific focus on Judaism, Hinduism and Christianity.
